January Learning Focus



Theme: It's Winter Time Again!

Colours: Blue (Dark/Light) and White

Shape: Rectangle & Shapes of the Moon (crescent, full-moon, half-moon etc.)

This month we will talk about winter weather, keeping warm and life in the polar lands.

Information books and mark making materials will be placed around the room to create opportunities for recording and researching. Children will continue to develop awareness that symbols, pictures and print convey meaning.

In association with winter themes, children will experiment with ice to explore the scientific concepts of freezing and melting. We will develop an awareness of animals and people that live in colder climates. Children will become aware of hibernation and how animals survive in cold weather. Through our own experiences we will find out how to keep safe and warm in winter.

The children are continuing to learn about how we can stay warm, healthy and well throughout the winter season.


Thanks to our new provision we aim to incorporate yoga and movement sessions into our timetable.
