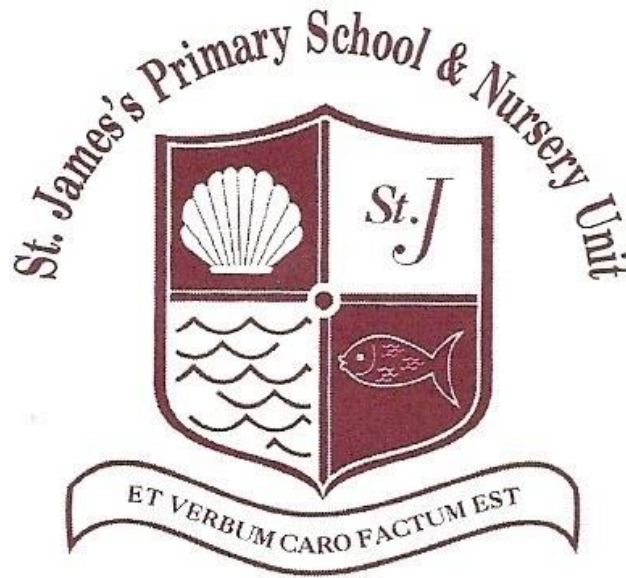


St James's Nursery News
